SCRIPTURE REFLECTION: In the gospel for this Sunday, Jesus calls together twelve disciples who are sent with the power and authority of Jesus to bring healing and hope to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. In calling them the TWELVE Jesus is trying to reconstitute not the tribes of Israel which had gotten confused through the many exiles and occupations of their land, but is trying to remind the individuals chosen and the chosen people of the gift of God described in the first reading, from the Book of Exodus. There in the desert of Sinai, God tells Moses that if the people hearken to his voice and keep his covenant, they will be God's special possession, a priestly kingdom, a holy nation. In accepting the call of the Lord Jesus to discipleship, we too become part of a priestly people and a holy nation – called to listen to the voice of God in every facet of our lives. How is God gathering us together these days and in this place? What work does God have in mind for each of us, for our Church, for our parish? How can we help one another fulfill the call each of us has received individually, as a parish, and as a worldwide church? -- Fr. Ron
