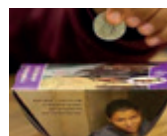

CRS RICE BOWL DISTRIBUTION

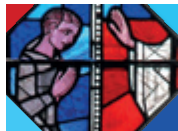

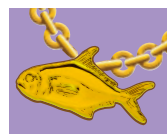
