Featured Leader- Eleanor Roosevelt was an American political figure, diplomat, and activist. She was the first lady of the United States from 1933 to 1945, during her husband President Franklin D. Roosevelt's four terms in office, making her the longest-serving first lady of the United States.

Did you know- Eleanor Roosevelt was not a member of the prominent Roosevelt family just by marriage, but was a Roosevelt in her own right. She and her husband, Franklin Delano Roosevelt, were actually fifth cousins once removed.

International Human Rights Day- Established December 10, 1948 Human Rights Day was created to commemorate and reinforce our commitment to the rights of all humans which is stated in the Bill of Rights. One of the core values of these rights is Equality- the declaration that everyone is equal before the law and has the right to equal protection and benefit of the law.
