CATHOLICS 14+ SHOULD ABSTAIN FROM MEAT ON ALL FRIDAYS DURING LENT.  
ON ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY, IN ADDITION TO ABSTINENCE, CATHOLICS 18-59 SHOULD ALSO FAST. FASTING ALLOWS FOR ONE FULL MEAL A DAY, WITH TWO SMALLER MEALS AND NOTHING BETWEEN MEALS (LIQUIDS ARE PERMITTED). CATHOLICS SHOULD NOT TAKE THESE RECOMMENDATIONS LIGHTLY, THOUGH SERIOUS HEALTH CONDITIONS MAY EXCUSE ONE FROM THESE OBLIGATIONS.
